### Assemblage blanc AOC, Optimo, Adrian & Diego Mathier, Salgesch

75 49.00

Heida, Ermitage, Amigne and Sylvaner. The Mathier Optimo white is dry, fruity strong and harmonious, supported by a finely integrated tannin structure.

### Cuvée blanc AOC, Madame Rosmarie Mathier, Salgesch

75 49.00

The Petite Arvine is responsible for the lovely freshness and the slight hint of salt. The Pinot Blanc gives it a hint of exotic fruit. The Pinot Gris gives Cuvée Madame Rosmarie Mathier its full body and is responsible for the slight residual sweetness. The Sylvaner gives it its longevity.

### **Fendant**

According to a legend, this grape variety, Chasselas or Gutedel, was introduced from Turkey by an ambassador of Francois I in the 16th century. It became native to Valais in the 19th century. With its refreshing character, it is the perfect culinary complement to local cheese dishes such as raclette and fondue.

Fendant has taken the hearts of the Valaisans by storm and has become an integral part of their social life!

## MUSCAT

Muscat cultivation in Valais dates back to the 16th century. Its excellent reputation can be seen in several historical documents from the 17th and 18th centuries. In the Sierre region, Muscat was cultivated until the reconstruction of the vineyard after the phylloxera infestation in 1930. Since then, the area planted with Muscat has declined sharply since then and has stabilized over the last fifteen years at around 40 hectares.

# Chardonnay

Chardonnay is a white grape variety with high quality potential. Snonyms are pinot Chardonnay, Beaunois, Morillon, White Clevner. The vine has become so important and sought-after that it has risen to the nobility of the wine world and is considered a noble grape. The Chardonnay is genotypically related to the Burgundy varieties. A DNA analysis carried out in 1998 revealed that Chardonnay is the result of a natural cross between Pinot and Gouais Blanc.

Diolinoir, Humagne rouge, Syrah. Graceful black-red color with violet reflections. Intense aroma of blackberries, strawberries and raspberries. The Salconio is very elegant, it is full of character and has a beautiful structure thanks to the Syrah. The full fruit thanks to the Diolinoir.

# Assemblage rouge AOC, Optimo, Adrian & Diego Mathier, Salgesch

Diolinoir, Gamaret, Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah. Mathier's Optimo impresses with a deep dark color, supported by finely integrated barrique and a massive tannin structure.

# **Pinot Noir**

The origin of Pinot Noir is still not entirely clear, but the parent variety Traminer is certain. The father is thought to be the Schwarzriesling. Pinot Noir is known for its ability to mutate, which has led to the giving rise to Pinot Gris and Pinot Blanc, among many other varieties. Apart from the color of the berries, the three varieties differ only slightly. Pinot Nor was probably already known in the French Burgundy already known in the fourth century. There is evidence that it existed in the 14th century. The name for the Pinot Noir was named after the pine cone shape of its grapes (pin=spruce cone).

# **Merlot**

As one of the medium to late-ripening grape varieties, Merlot, which is cultivated in almost all major wine-growing countries has also developed in Valais. It loves soils that are not too dry and finds its ideal conditions on loamy soils, which are often found at the beginning of the slope.

### Cornalin

A true treasure of Valais heritage, Cornalin can boast of being one of the oldest grape varieties in the canton. It originates one hundred percent from the Valais. The Cornalin bears few fruits and ripens late and must be planted in very sunny locations. This is why it has discouraged generations of winegrowers. It owes its return to the limelight to its aristocracy. Its color with violet reflections presents a delicately complex bouquet, a perfect body which, despite a somewhat exuberant youth, is splendid and develops tremendous finesse with age. Rich wine, wild berry flavor, fine nose.

## Cornalin Gold Barrique AOC, Varonier & Söhne, Varen

Splendid red color. The nose is dominated by aromas of black cherries, sour cherries, blackberries and blueberries. The strong acidity gives the wine a lot of freshness and liveliness. Well-integrated tannins. Exceptionally long finish.

# **Syrah**

Passion and enthusiasm were the witnesses to the marriage of Wallis and Syrah! He gained his reputation in the northern Hermitage wine region of the Côtes du Rhône and later successfully acquired the distant warm landscapes of Australia and California.

Since its introduction to Valais in 1926, this grape has continued to develop with proud success. In sunny slopes, which correspond to its late harvest, the Syrah brings out the best of its concentrated, full-bodied fruit with broad aromas. What a beautiful structure and lasting strength! Arguments that become more and more true with time. Red wine with a very dark color, with a scent of violets, with intense aromas of blackcurrant, elderberry and spices (pepper and clove). This wine with long aging in new oak barrels from Bordeaux (for one year) and accompanies beef, sheep, game and cheese.
